	Trail. Markers every kilometre (or half kilometer) can be made with painted stones. Once we get an inventory and budget, we can purchase the materials and get the signs installed, possibly as soon as Wed. May 26.	
	Extension to McGillivray Drive: It was agreed that this extension be considered as a project. Val to contact Dean Van Rentels. Bruce to contact Paul Hodgins to confirm he's okay with an extension. Assuming we get approvals, we could get started on this extension as soon as Wed. May 26.	Val / Bruce
	Terry Jacques Trail : Vic and Val walked the trail behind Terry Jacques home towards Denfield road on May 12. They could get ³ / ₄ of the way to Denfield road before having to go up the bank to the back lawns of the last 3 houses before Denfield Road. Its unclear whether these landowners actually own the land that has been turned into back lawn but, in an event, a trail over these lawns may not be well received (although MacNaughton Morrison trail has trails through several back lawns, so this situation is possible). Bruce to check with township staff on property line situation there. Terry appears receptive to a trail although finding a public access is a question. Going from Terry's place towards town may only involve a few landowners, so that option should be investigated as well. Bruce to check with township of landowners – ideally to find out the landowners between Terry's place and Jackie Marrtens, who has already indicated that she is receptive to trails on her land.	Bruce
	Walnut Grove Trail: The situation at the end of Terry Jacques trail near Denfield Road brought up the issue of establishing a trail quickly once development over those areas begins. It is better to have a trail in place – even in a rough form – before landowners extend their lawns and other features. As such, it was agreed that we approach the township staff about establishing a trail – even in rough form – behind Walnut Grove.	
	South Side of Benn Drain: Not a priority at this time, although it could be	
	Trail #4 North of Car Wash: Not a priority at this time.	
	South of South Branch of Benn Drain: In chatting with Lions President Ken Curtis, he indicated that he knows landowner Ed Butler and could approach him about build a trail on land he owns that is currently zoned open space. Also, we could approach Langford Lumber about continuing the trail along the trail past their store. Ken indicated that he would assist in approaching these landowners. Bruce to contact Ken about getting these meetings on track.	Bruce, Ken
5	Volunteers: Once we have a plan and budget for the Hodgins trail, there will be some work getting the signs installed that may be appropriate for third-party volunteers. Jessica reported that there have been no contacts from high-school students as a result of the posters put up at the schools. Suzy will put posters up at South Huron High School as well. However, it was felt that if we can actually get a project that involves putting shovels into the ground, we won't have much trouble getting volunteers from Lucan Trails members, running clubs, etc.
